The challenges


Preserving biodiversity threatened by the artificialisation of environments, the intensification of agriculture or the agricultural loss.

For the natural environments

The network of sites hosts remarkable fauna and flora heritage challenges. The project aims to improve the conservation status of 24 habitats (forests, ponds, etc.), and more than 80 species of Community interest (insects, birds, amphibians, bats, plants, etc.). Its objective is to preserve and restore ecosystems and their services such as pollination or the preservation of water quality.

For the agricultural environments


The project aims to strengthen the contribution of agriculture to the maintenance and improvements of biodiversity, through the commitment of farmers of the Occitanie region in an agroecological transition process and the experimentation of economically viable practices that enhance natural resources.



The sites of the LIFE Biodiv'Paysanne

These are natural areas representative of the diversity of the regional ecosystems, such as heathlands and shrubs, dry grasslands, meadows, forests or wetlands. The project also relies on a network of 60 farms with a variety of animal and crop productions.




